Theme: Guided by the Eye of God

Text: *Psalm 32:8 NKJV*

I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go;

I will guide you with My eye.

Thought: We are guided by others' eyes in two ways. First, very few children, wives or husbands have not been forcibly guided by the stare of their parent or partner! But we're also guided by another's eye when we work or play closely with another-as on a team. We sense their intentions and thoughts because we're aware of what they are focused upon. That's why people who work together effectively don't have to be told what the other is thinking or what they should do to help. Model employees are not those who wait for someone to tell them what to do. Everyone breathes more easily when the new person on the job no longer has to be told what to do at every stage.

In the same way, we are guided by God's "eye" when our will and thoughts are immersed in what God is doing in this world and the attitudes in which God customarily works.

Reflection:

- Reflect upon what God is doing in this world that you are or what to be a part of.
- What are God's thoughts about this endeavor?
- Ask God to help you to be led by His eye (mind) on this matter.
