

Privacy Notice

This document was last updated on February 22, 2019

This privacy notice discloses the privacy practices for Visalia Community Church of Christ (VCCOC) and our website; <http://www.vccoc.org>. This privacy notice applies solely to information collected by this website, except where stated otherwise. It will notify you of the following:

- What information we collect;
- With whom it is shared;
- How it can be corrected;
- How it is secured;
- How policy changes will be communicated; and
- How to address concerns over misuse of personal data.

Information Collection, Use, and Sharing

We are the sole owners of the information collected on this site. We do not collect any personal information about you unless you voluntarily provide it to us. However, you may be required to provide certain personal information to us when you elect to use certain services available on the site. These may include:

- (a) registering for an account on our site (Personal Data: first and last name, email, username, website password);
- (b) sending us an email message (Personal Data: first and last name, email);
- (c) submitting emergency and liability forms (Personal Data: first and last name, date of birth, address, phone, emergency contact, medical insurance, any medical conditions).

We will not sell or rent this information to anyone.

We will use your information to respond to you, regarding the reason you contacted us. We will not share your information with any third party outside of our organization.

Your Access to and Control Over Information

You may opt out of any future contacts from us at any time. You can do the following at any time by contacting us via the email address or phone number provided on our website:

- See what data we have about you, if any.
- Change/correct any data we have about you.
- Have us delete any data we have about you.
- Express any concern you have about our use of your data

Security

We take precautions to protect your information. When you submit sensitive information via the website, your information is protected both online and offline.

Only VCCOC employees who need the information to perform a specific job are granted access to personally identifiable information. The computers/servers on which we store personally identifiable information are kept in a secure environment.

Cookies & Log Data

We use "cookies" and Log Data on this site to monitor site usage through Google Analytics. A cookie is a piece of data stored on a site visitor's hard drive to help us improve your access to our site and identify repeat visitors to our site. For instance, when we use a cookie to identify you, you would not have to log in a password more than once, thereby saving time while on our site. Usage of a cookie is in no way linked to any personally identifiable information on our site. If you would like to opt out, you may choose to set your web browser to refuse cookies, or to alert you when cookies are being sent.

Log Data may include information such as your computer's Internet Protocol ("IP") address, browser type, browser version, the pages of our site that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages and other statistics.

Do Not Track (DNT) Requests

As our website uses Google Analytics to monitor site usage, we are unable to honor the DNT setting of a user's web browser.

Children's Privacy

In accordance with our insurance policy, we do collect required medical information, treatment permission, and liability release from the parents of children active in our children's and youth ministries.
